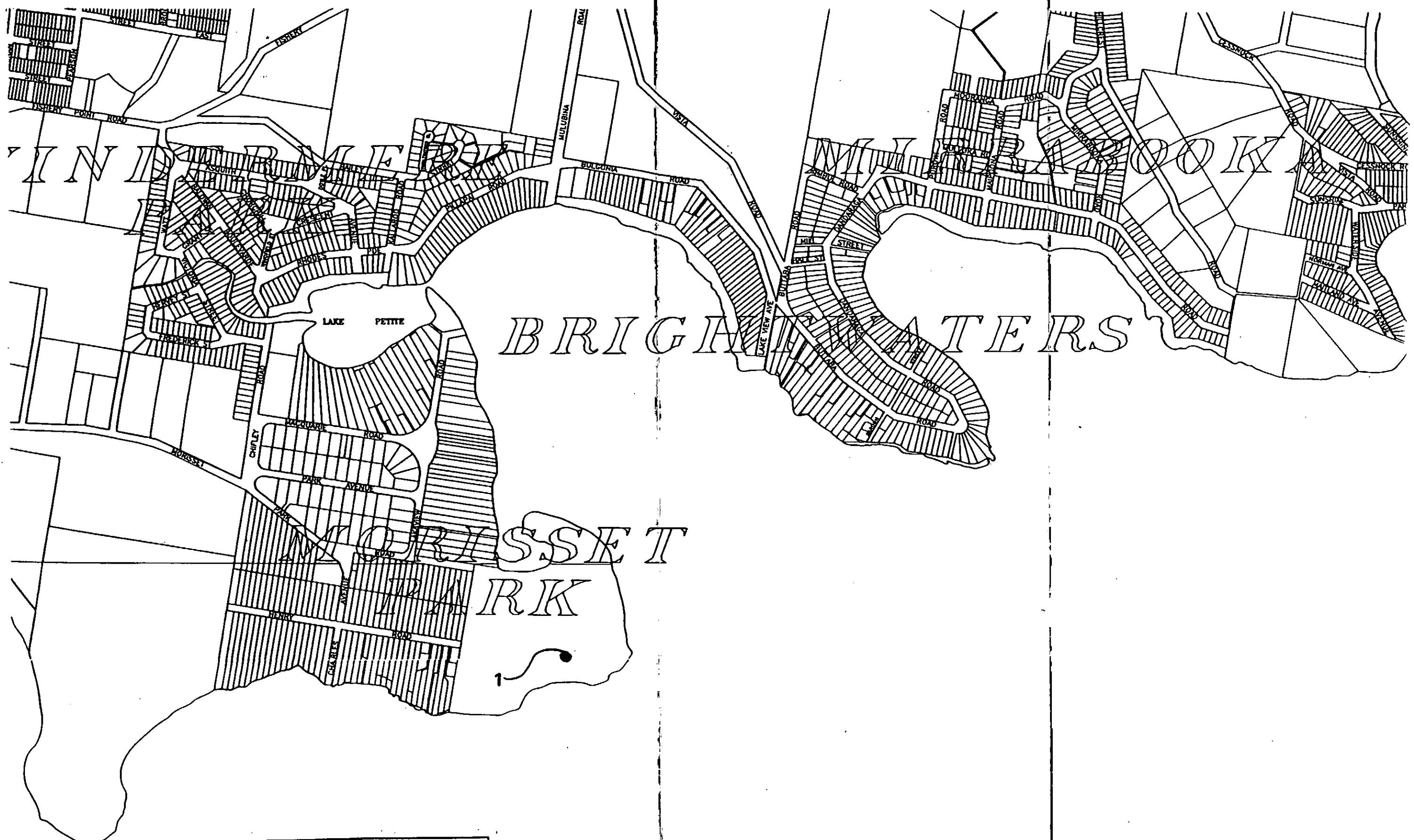

HISTORICAL NOTES:	Land (the Bluff) bought bought by Solicitor JA Gorrick 1902. His daughter Ivy & husband Bert Bailey, an actor, built Kendall Grange, a big house, in 1918. Site sold to an order of nuns in 1934, who established a T.B. hospital & cemetery there. Sold to Brothers of St John of God in 1947. They established a special school on the site.
