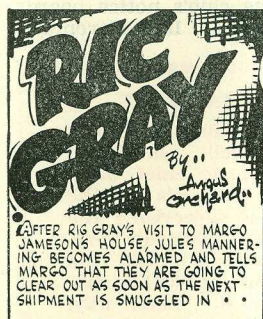

Four of the lost time accidents were caused by sprains, two due to foreign bodies in eyes and the other to burns (contact with hot cinders).

The frequency rate for the period has improved in comparison with the previous period, but greater care by employees, with better housekeeping would have prevented most of the accidents.

Attention has been drawn to the practice of discarding clothing, thereby exposing the body to unnecessary risks. This cannot be over-emphasized.
