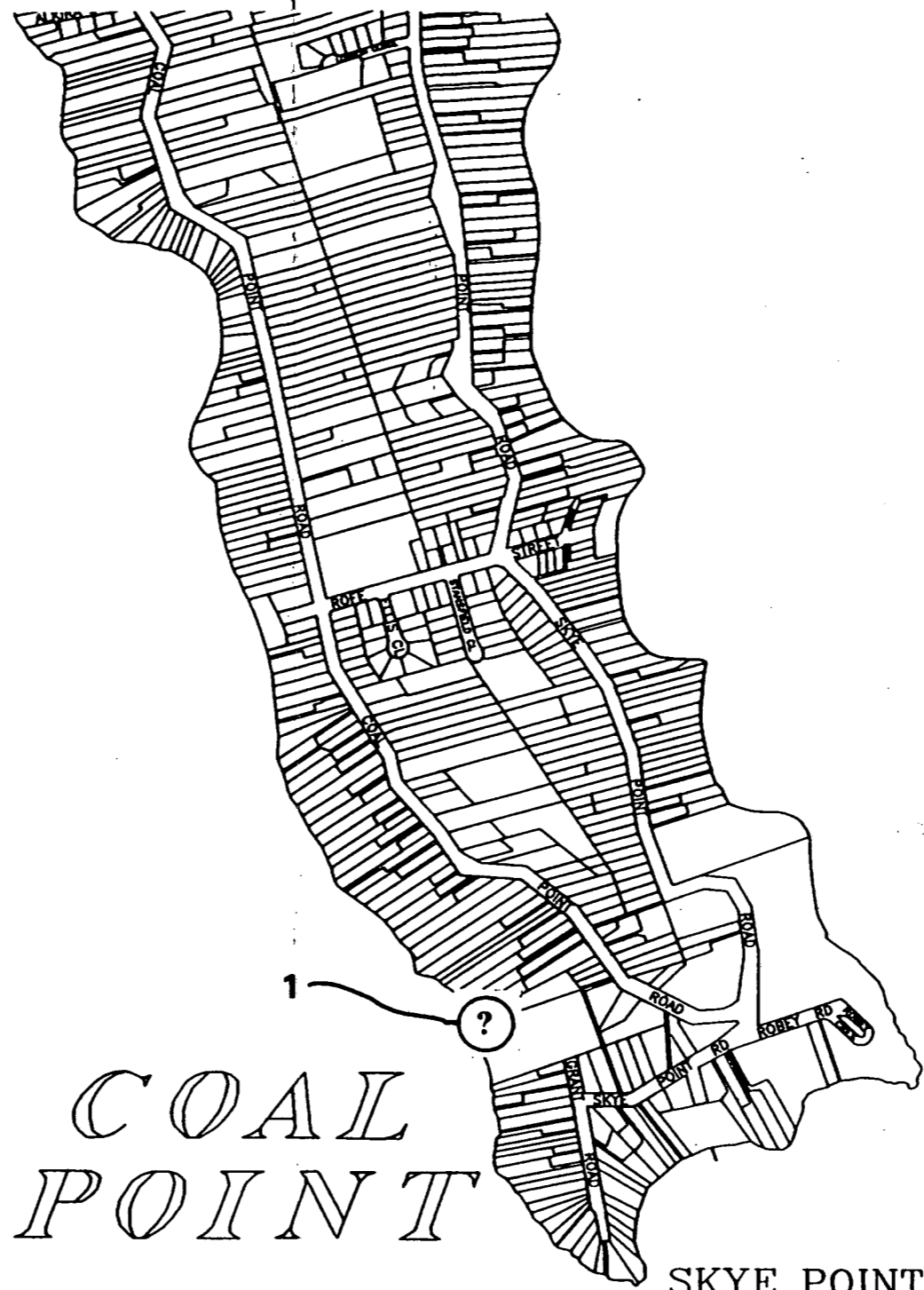

<b>HISTORICAL NOTES:</b>	The mine was worked by Threlkeld from 1841 for about 3 years Threlkeld became heavily in debt, and the estate was sold by the mortgagee. The mine was leased by several people over the years, often lying idle. As South Hetton Colliery it was worked as late as 1906.

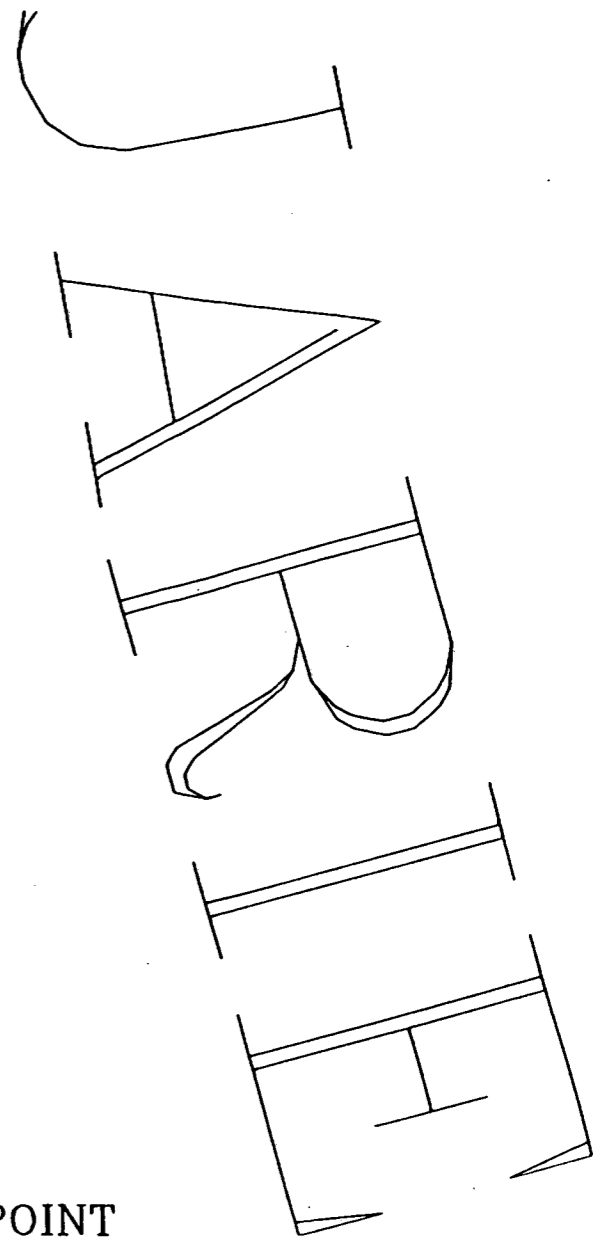
