



A group of gravestones at the Wyee Cemetery. The cast iron surround on the grave in the foreground is one of the most ornate seen in the district. The grave is that of two small children, who died in 1921 & 1925, & of their mother, who died many years later. The headstone & surround probably date from 1921, but it has very Victorian style. (Doring Neg. 403.17)

Bottom: This pair of gravestones & surrounds are most unusual. The dates on them are 1947 and 1948. The headstones have circular marble inserts with dates and names. The footstones have "Mum" and "Dad" picked out (Doring Neg. 403.18) in small sea-shells.


