

<p>DESCRIPTION: Small, open, picnic shelter in a small park on the lakefront. The timber posts are set on concrete bases. The floor is set up with fixed tables & bench seats. The shelter is painted green with red (eaves) and cream (frieze) trim. The shelter is close to a minor wharf and swimming pool in the lake.</p>																						
MODIFICATIONS: concrete post bases appear to have been added after building.
