With reference to your letter of the 29 March, I am directed by His Excellency the Governor to inform you that it is not in his power at the present moment to make a definitive arrangement, or to state on what conditions, or to what extent you will be allowed Land as a disbanded Officer; But that there will be no objection to your receiving Twelve hundred and Eighty Acres of Land as a ~~Disbanded~~ subject to such conditions as shall be determined on.
